

# Rotating Tops

- **Blue Point Hoptical Illusion**

This India Pale Ale from Long Island, New York strikes a nice, drinkable balance between malt and hops. Great for hot weather days like this! 6.8%, \$5 pints

- **Brewdog Paradox Isle of Arran Strong Stout**: Begin with a smashing 10% Imperial Stout, then age it in single-malt Scotch barrels from Isle of Arran distillery. Did we mention that these barrels were formally used to mature sherry? Well, they were. After ageing, you're left with an Imperial Stout that takes the notes of Scotch and sherry. An incredibly rare beer. 10% Alcohol, \$10 goblets

- **Harpoon Leviathan: Big Bohemian Pilsner**

Part of Harpoon's limited Leviathan Series, this Imperial Pilsner follows the classic recipe of a Bohemian Pilsner and then doubles it! Nine percent alcohol, plenty hoppy and lots of 2-row malt make this beer dangerously drinkable. 9% ABV, \$6.50 pints

- **Radeberger Pilsner**

A classic German Pilsner perfect for hot summer days. Order a pint and keep a Radeberger glass while supplies last! 4.8% ABV, \$4.75 per pint

- **Sierra Nevada 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary: Fritz & Ken's Stout**

The first in a series of brews to commemorate Sierra Nevada's 30<sup>th</sup> year of brewing. This beer is a collaboration between craftbrew pioneers Ken Grossman and Fritz Maytag. A 10% Imperial Stout that is dry, roasty and remarkably smooth. \$6 goblets

- **Stone Ruination IPA**

From Stone Brewing in San Diego, this Imperial IPA was one of the first brews to crack the 100 IBU barrier. It's bold, it's hoppy and it's potent. It'll also do a number on your taste buds. Not for the uninitiated. 7.7%, \$6.5 pints
